PRESIDENT'S REPORT 1989/90

Kenthurst fielded six junior teams again this season consisting of U/11, two U/13, U/14 and two U/15 sides with good results achieved.

Even though the Committee canvassed schools in the ares, we were unable to fill teams for U/10, U/12 or U/16. The U/10 team is a very important grade for junior cricketers to learn the game as they play "Average Cricket" and each player has the same chance with bat and ball. Being without U/12 leaves a gap in the age group that usually continues through that teams age group as it has with this years U/16 age group. The result is that there is no input into the senior teams the following year. The juniors are the foundation stone of the Club and without continued registrations the senior teams find it difficult to fill numbers in their teams to maintain the Club strength. So, if you have a mate or friend who would like to play cricket for Kenthurst Cricket Club, ring your manager or coach and he can let you know the registration date (early August) at Kenthurst Park.

This is the twelfth year of the Junior Club Champion sponsored by Mr. A. Baxter and my congratulations go to the winner.

I would like to thank the teams for their sportsmanship throughout the season, the managers and coaches for their time and efforts and also the junior coaching panel organised by Mr. K. Napper, which helped out with teams on request by their managers. My thanks also to the scorers and parents for their assistance and continued support.

The team enjoyed as uccessful season and finished with 63 points, which is hard to believe was not good enough to get into the final. Our first game against North Turramurra was probably the only game where we were not in a winning position at some stage and Kenthurst was the only team to take points off Mount Colah, who remained undefeated. There was a marked improvement in personal performances by nearly every player in every department. Once again Tim was our foremost batsman despite missing 3 games. Michael had little luck but bowled beatifully to record a fine season, all the other bowlers supported him and shared the wickets. Peter finally recorded a hat-trick and against Mt.Colah Our 3 close-in fielders Simon, Luke and Peter had an outstanding season and accounted for over 30 dismissals. Simon's keeping was excellent and rated a favourable mention every week. The difference between our performance and the opposition was that Kenthurst scored nearly 1800 runs for the loss of 90 wickets from 13 innings, our average of 20 runs per wicket, our opponents had 17 innings to score 1350 runs for 132 wickets lost to average 10 runs per wicket.

During the season the team gained new players who performed with great distinction and next season should be outstanding if the potential in the team is realised. The team is grateful for the parents who got the boys to training regularly and for always having the players at the games early as these two factors proved crucial to our success. Our supporters are an integral part of the team and our thanks especially to Peter Dooley every Saturday, and Tom Jaaniste who filled in whenever needed.
