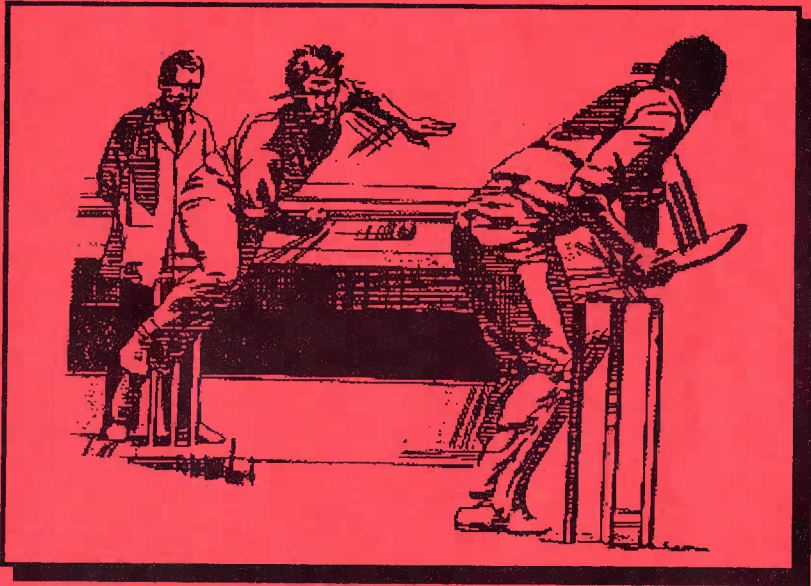

- **Other Batting Performances** - Shannon Evans 63 - Bjorn Holston 40 and Adam Maini 36.

It was a terrific team effort to win our last game of the season against Normanhurst who needed a win to make the U/16 final - their team consisted of three District Representatives and a Northern District Third Grader.

I have been very proud to have assisted the boys in improving their knowledge of the game and to know that their "on field" behaviour was easily the most outstanding in our competition. I sincerely hope that they will all seriously consider to play their senior cricket with the Club to fulfil their potential and enjoyment of the game.
