

The 1999/00 season was a period which saw the rebuilding of teams in the Upper Hills Cricket Club. We were unable to field an under 11, 15 and 16 side because we did not having enough players from those particular age groups. However we did have a record of 5 Under 10 sides, 52 players in total, and around 47 Kanga players which meant that 99 out of 134 junior members were below 10 years of age. This is very encouraging, and hopefully the Club will be able to field a full compliment of players in every age group in the not too distant future.

Congratulations to our Under 13 side for being the most successful team this year, they were premiers at the end of round 10 but lost the Grand Final to West Pennant Hills by only one run

The Club continues to have excellent representation in the HK & HDCA representative teams. We wish the players success and hope that they will continue to pursue their cricket in the future.

Training

In order to maintain and provide quality coaches to the Kanga cricketers, 5 Kanga coaches were sponsored by the club to complete the Level 0 coaching clinic at St Leo's College. The Level 0 course was a one day event held on a Sunday. Many thanks to the participants who devote much of their free time to train the Juniors and Kanga Players.

A training day was also provided by the Senior players in January which was most successful with over 36 Junior Players attending the event. Many thanks to the Club's committee, and our young senior players who contributed in the training session and organization of the events for the day.

Craig Waddell, one of our current young A Grade cricketers was sponsored by the Club to provide coaching assistance to our under 12, 13 and 14 Junior teams. The training program commenced in December and continued through to the end of February. Craig's help enabled one on one coaching to occur, hopefully to remedy the individual cricket problems that players may have, and something that is difficult for the team coach to solve in a group situation. The Club also provides Juniors selected by the Executive Committee, for coaching at Bill Madden's Coaching Clinic. Bill Madden provides 25% sponsorship to this program, which consists of a 10 week coarse and enables us to train about 6-10 Junior players annually. 




Rory Chaloner: This was Rory Chaloner's first season at cricket and he did very well. He finished with the second best batting average of 34. He only got out three times in the whole season.



the batsmen struggling to deal with the ball.



Daniel Thompson: He has developed a great rhythm in his bowling action and will be an accurate speedster in the future, he also bats better than he thinks he does





different things to get wickets.




