On the 30th July 2020 Gary Stasi lost his fight against bowel cancer at the tender age of 68.

Gary debuted at Kenthurst Cricket Club in 1995 and played 20 seasons for the club. Scoring 2642 runs at an average of 16.94. His most memorable innings was shared with Paul Muston in D grade in 2012/13. Together they scored an unbeaten 226 runs with Gary ending up with 122 not out. This 5th wicket partnership is still a club record.

Gary was more known for his spin bowling. Taking an impressive 265 wickets at an average of 19.92 with a personal best of 7/21. Nine times he took a 5 fa.

Loving the game as he did he toured with the Banksias in 1997 and 2001 to the UK.

In 2016/17 the club was able to submit a team into the classics over 50's competition to which he played 3 seasons. Gary was one half of the spin twins to open the bowling with his long time friend Jim Welsh. There were many times you could hear "Bowling Gary" by his skipper Mick Dolly and by those spectators on the balcony at the Kenthurst Clubhouse. A great way to finish off a hard day in the field was to have a relaxing beer with the fellas whilst having a laugh about anything and everything.

Jim Welsh would like to share his thoughts on Gary:

If ever you had a Life Time Friend that would be Gary.

We met at Telopea Public School in 1959 and had been Friends for 61 years.

Gary still has many friends from Telopea. Gary was a person that everybody liked and he never had a bad word to say about anybody even in dire circumstances he always had a smile. Gary will be missed by many people including those that knew him over twenty five years of playing cricket at Kenthurst Cricket Club.

May he rest in peace.

Similarly in on the 2001 tour. At one stage of the venture in 2001 we were looking we could not meet the requirement of fulfilling a group. Gary was active in the recruitment of Joe Prince so we have a tour. Gary also played the role of being the room mate for Max Olde. So much did Max appreciate his efforts what Gary did as a favour -like make Max's cup of tea in the morning became an expectation. Gary also on both tours mixed with the locals and experienced each of cities we visited. His sense of humour about satirising situations when the locals may have seemed to have had a better of a situation has stuck with me. Invariably I use one of Gary's quotes – Yep we got those Aussies again - in similar circumstances in my travels.


Sports tours have a reputation for being raucous affairs. I can say Gary was a perfect gentleman on tour.

U/12's Season Report - 2019/2020

The 2019/20 season was a significant one for the under 12's as seven out of our ten-member squad were playing with a hard ball for the first time or playing cricket for the first time. Given this backdrop, we missed the finals narrowly and ended up as the 6th placed team with 11 wins and 4 losses after 17 rounds. Two of these games were washed out towards the end of the season and this probably cost us the chance of playing in the finals.

The team boasted of the leading run getter in the comp, Tom Medford with 510 runs at an average of 102 and Neel Jetley the leading wicket taker in the comp with 19 wickets at a strike rate of 14.79. We had two outstanding performers for the season with 10 –year-old Tom Medford missing out narrowly in breaking the all-time run scoring record for the comp and also taking a hat trick, whilst Neel Jetley ended number 6th in the overall batting rankings in the comp with 314 runs at 52.33 to go with his top rank in bowling in the comp.

We also saw some impressive batting performances from three 9-year-olds. Jarryd Ratwatte who ended up at number 12 in the batting rankings in the comp with 254 runs at an average of 31.75, Neil Maini who was number 20 in the comp with 230 runs at 28.75 and Isuru Wickrama 193 runs at 32.17.

The team had four players who were playing the game for the first time, brothers Callum & Ethan Keeble, Alexander (Alex) Wilson and Isaiah Buultjens. Callum and Alex put in some impressive performances towards the end of the season and showed that they had improved vastly in their batting and bowling, which augurs well for their cricket going forward. Isaiah and 9-year-old Ethan gained some invaluable experience playing with the group and had developed their batting and bowling significantly by the end of the season. Hopefully, they can build on this in the next season and keep enjoying their cricket.

On the bowling front Neel Jetley was well supported by the Wickrama brothers Kavindu & Isuru, Tom Medford, Neil Maini and Jarryd Ratwatte. Kavindu, only played a handful of games for the club this season, but had the best strike rate of 12.88 in his 6 games with 8 wickets.

Wicket keeping duties were shared by Tom and Alex, whilst Tom was very safe behind the stumps, Alex showed great promise being a wicket keeper for the first time.

I would like to thank all the parents for their support during the season and to Michelle Medford for scoring and updating the stats every week.

Also, a big thank you from the team and the parents to our junior president Brendon Lowndes, for answering our calls for balls, kit, wickets etc... and his support.

Hope the boys enjoyed the experience and wish them every success in their cricket ahead.

Banksias 2019 Virtual Tour

When I was asked to write a report for the Banksias this year my immediate answer was, we did nothing this last season. I was then told that in fact there was a tour of two to England and you saw two test matches. Further you were also in England for two world cup matches. Rather than bore all and sundry about all the places I visited including the family holiday to continental Europe and Morocco I will give a brief recap on what I did and corelate to what the core values of the Kenthurst Banksias are.

I was lucky enough to go to two dominant displays by the Australians in the Cricket World Cup. I was also in London at the same time they beat the eventual winners of the cup in pool match It was not the results of the games it was the experience of being there. This can be said about going on a Banksia tour. Too often Banksia tours are judged on the results on the field. I can recall after the 2013 tour I had someone say how was this successful tour when you lost all your games and Australia lost the Ashes? I replied it was all about the experience. One of the highlights of the world cup side of the trip was being able to sit with the Bangladeshi supporters and their passion for their team and the gracious way they accepted defeat after the game speaks volumes about them and amplifies what the preface of the laws of cricket is about in the Spirit of the Game.

From the Ashes perspective I was lucky enough to be in Cricket Australia tour for the Edgbaston test. I used to think they were expensive tours but having been one now I can say it was an experience that was well worth it. We were entertained by a pre-match function with speakers including Glenn McGrath, Travis Head, Marcus Harris, Marnus Labuschagne and Graham Gooch and was hosted by ABC Jim Maxwell. This was a prelude for the test and was very entertaining.

Being able to go to the test was one of the highlights for me. The banter between the Australians and English supporters as well as seeing Steve Smith's herculean effort. One of the main issues I have had in the past is trying to guarantee tickets when promoting trips to England. As hard as respective travel agents have tried it is getting harder with every tour. I feel that in future we can have an independent tour with the Cricket Australia tour programmed within of our tour. The eventual result with Australia winning the test was icing on the cake. However, similar to my world cup experience it was not about the result it was more about the people I met and the experience I had. Further leading up to the test I was able to catch up with a couple of members from the Badsey Cricket Club who the Banksias had played on all of the Banksia tours of England. Further I went to the third day of Lords test which was predominately washed out however it added to the experience of an Ashes trip.

So like Banksias tours I saw (however did not play) some great cricket, met interesting people, visited some breathtaking, historical, as well fascinating places and it was an overall a very good experience.

As I write the world is currently trying to deal with the COVID-19 virus. With the uncertainty of this pandemic I cannot guarantee what the program for the Banksias will be for the next twelve months. We had intended to have a trip to Sussex Inlet in September and go to the Adelaide test against India. We will have to wait and see.

Authors note – For the Ashes part of the tour I was accompanied by Phillip Jones who was the only person who had financially contributed to the Banksia tour. Rather than cancel the tour I decided that we have a similar trip.
